The report shows both the 2015–16 and 2016–17 data for a grade from the current year, as well as data for the preceding grade from the previous administration in a side-by-side view. • The Number Tested now excludes students who only logged on to one part of the Smarter Balanced assessment beginning with the 2016–17 data.
